Music for the All-State Concert will be sent to you at our home address as soon as the forms are received. Check with your teacher to see if your school is going to assist with payment of the fee. ***If so, please indicate that on the form.*** Please return the form and fee promptly – If we don't hear from you by 12/21, we may be forced to fill your seat with the next available alternate.

Please check your calendar carefully to be sure that you can meet ***all*** of the required rehearsals, and the concert. **Students who miss any part of any rehearsal will be dismissed from the All-State Band.** If you cannot meet the requirements of the rehearsal / concert schedule, please ask your band director to notify me immediately that you will not be participating. Once you withdraw, you will be replaced and will not be reinstated.

It is also important for you to know in advance that *the assignment of parts and seating may be changed to balance this ensemble for the performance, and also at the discretion of the conductor and All-State Committee.* Soloists will be chosen during the rehearsals; therefore you should learn any solo written in your parts.

Our guest conductor this year is Dr. Stephen Miles, Supervisor of Music for Baltimore County Public Schools. Dr. Miles will provide an excellent musical opportunity for you, as the ensemble prepares for an outstanding All-State Band Concert. Please prepare your music before the rehearsals. It goes without saying that your cooperation and behavior must be exemplary at all of the rehearsals and the performance.

The **required** concert dress code is as follows:

- Girls:**
- White collared buttoned blouse with  $\frac{3}{4}$  or long sleeves. Midriff must be covered and blouse must be tucked in.
  - Black skirt which covers the knees when seated, or black slacks which are full-cut and formal.
  - Stockings which are black or off-black in color.
  - Low-heel black dress shoes.
  - Minimal amount of jewelry.
- Boys:**
- Dark trousers.
  - Brown or black dress shoes (NO sneakers!).
  - Dark socks.
  - White dress shirt with appropriate tie.

**Students who do not meet the dress code will not be allowed on the concert stage.**

# **DIRECTIONS TO CAESAR RODNEY HIGH SCHOOL**

## **From the North:**

- Take **Rt. 1 South** to **Exit 97**
- Turn **LEFT** at the bottom of the exit onto **Rt. 13 South**
- Continue on Rt. 13 through 2 lights.
- Shortly after the 2<sup>nd</sup> light, bear **RIGHT** into Camden.
- Turn **RIGHT** at 1<sup>st</sup> light
- Caesar Rodney HS on your **RIGHT**.

## **From the South:**

- Take **Rt. 13 North** to Camden.
- Turn **LEFT** at intersection of **Rt. 10 and Rt. 13** (Eckert Drug Store/Dairy Queen on your left)
- Turn **RIGHT** at the first light.
- Turn **LEFT** at the next light.
- School parking lot will be on your **RIGHT**.

## **OR**

- Take **Rt. 113 North/Rt. 1 North**, exit **RIGHT** onto **Rt. 10** towards Camden.
- Turn **LEFT** at light off exit onto **Rt. 10** (DAFB on right)
- Follow **Rt. 10** to intersection of **Rt. 10 and Rt. 13**.
- Cross over **Rt. 13** into Camden.
- Turn **RIGHT** at the light.
- Turn **LEFT** at the next light.
- School parking lot will be on your **RIGHT**.
